Friends of the Rainforest is dedicated to promoting a sustainable world by educating and inspiring children and adults to take action to protect, support, and expand the Rainforest through our education programs, grants, and ecotours.

IT ALL STARTED IN 1987...

... when a group of Swedish school children started a worldwide fundraising effort to purchase rainforest land in Monteverde, Costa Rica to protect its priceless natural treasures forever. This land became the Children's Eternal Rainforest, one of the largest private preserves in Costa Rica. Our founder, Rachel Crandell, took her passion for the Rainforest, conservation, and education and created Friends of the Rainforest (then called the Monteverde Conservation League U.S.) to carry on her mission of connecting kids and adults to the Rainforest and sharing her love and enthusiasm.

Thank you to our wonderful community of supporters, educators, and partners for helping us achieve such an incredible year full of exciting new accomplishments and successes.

Despite the challenges that 2021 posed, we were able to reach as many kids and adults through our education program as in years past. With our take-home kits and lending library, we interacted with students in new ways. Through our new partnerships with Exploring by the Seat of Your Pants and the St. Louis Public Library, we engaged with more students virtually on a range of new platforms.

In 2021, we held a variety of different virtual events. We brought our donors together to celebrate and share memories of the Rainforest. We presented on Environmental Racism and how we can support Climate Justice initiatives in our cities. In November, we virtually hosted 13 teams from all over the world for our 7th Annual Trivia Night event in support of our mission and programming.

In 2022, we celebrate our 20th Anniversary as an organization. We began 2022 strong with a crucial land purchase grant to the Monteverde Conservation League, fully funded in Winter 2021 by our incredible donors. This grant permitted the purchase of a 46.9-acre piece of previously-privately-owned farmland.

We have scheduled our first EcoTour trip since the start of the pandemic for this March. We are excited to reestablish this essential part of our programming. Our EcoTour programming is a meaningful way to connect kids and adults to the Rainforest in a way that minimizes their impact on the forest itself.

Thank you so much to everyone for an amazing year. We are so excited for what 2022 holds.

SPRING



In April, Friends of the Rainforest celebrated **Environmental Education Week** for the second year in a row. We released four new YouTube videos that week and then hosted our firstever **Educational Happy Hour** where Jamie and Sophie discussed Environmental Racism and Climate Justice.

In May, we participated in **Give STL Day**, an annual day of giving in the St. Louis area, raising \$8,627 for Friends of the Rainforest.

SUMMER



June 22nd was **World Rainforest Day**. For this day, Friends of the Rainforest hosted our first ever Rainforest Chat for our supporters to come and share their stories, and then we were out in the community hosting a fundraiser at Earthbound Brewing in St. Louis.

July and August presented two tabling opportunities, one at the **Dragonfly Festival** at the Butterfly House and another at a **Local Homeschool Resource Fair**.

In October, Friends of the Rainforest partnered with the **St. Louis Public Library** to host two virtual lessons, one incorporating one of our Lending Library lessons.

In November, Jamie was featured on **Exploring by the Seat of Your Pants**, reaching new classrooms all over the world. The following week, we held our **7th Annual Trivia Night** virtually, raising \$7,084. After not being able to host Trivia last year, we were thrilled to have pulled off such a successful event!

Environmental Education in Monteverde


Effective environmental education programming is one of the most important ways we can ensure the conservation of the Children's Eternal Rainforest (CER) in perpetuity. Environmental education is particularly important for Costa Rican youth because of their proximity to the Rainforest itself. While there are many communities and schools surrounding the CER, it's not always accessible to nearby schools and families. In 2021, Friends of the Rainforest provided the Monteverde Conservation League with a grant to support MCL's newest education initiative: the Puntos de Cultura project. MCL has been able to bring groups from local schools and orphanages, as well as family groups, to the Rainforest to learn about the flora, fauna, climate change, and what they can do to protect the Rainforest. They planted trees, did yoga by Lake Pocosol, and had reflective drawing time after. For many of the participants, it was their first time visiting the Rainforest, despite living so close by.

This was one of MCL's first in-person education programs since March 2020 when they closed at the beginning of the pandemic, and we're super excited to see the success they had in engaging kids through this outdoor learning programming!
