#### #11 MABI

The Monteverde Arenal Bioregion Initiative's mission is to define a common vision, key objectives, and a tractable action plan for conservation, research, and education initiatives in the Monteverde Arenal bioregion.

This grant provides funds for both conference preparation as well as attendance costs for the Monteverde Institute Coordinator.

#### **#13 MCL Executive Director**

This grant provides "seed money" to establish a new position to oversee outreach and improve the quality of stations and trails, help the board update their strategic plan, and effectively manage day-to-day administration of MCL.


#### **#12 MABI Conference**

The purpose of the Monteverde Arenal Bioregion Initiative's conference is to expand the impact and scope of the collective actions to sufficiently address the developing problems that threaten this region. The conference will be bilingual, inter-organizational, and interdisciplinary; reflecting the diversity of the human and natural communities.

#### **#14 Critical Upgrades**

This grant provides funds for critical equipment and infrastructure upgrades at the San Gerardo Station in the Children's Eternal Rainforest with improvements in radio communication, installation of a battery bank, and stabilization of power delivery to the station.
